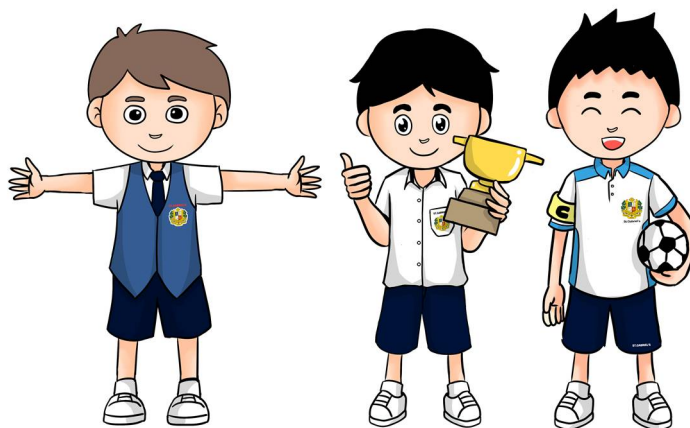




***Day 1 (4 January 2022) – Recess is from 9.00 a.m. to 9.30 a.m.**

Students are encouraged to pack dry food (e.g. cereal, bread and biscuits and etc.) We strongly encourage our students to choose water over sugared beverages.

There will be teachers and prefects on duty during his recess to assist your child/children. Should there be any updates on school arrangements, we will inform you via Parents Gateway. Hence, kindly ensure that you enable the push notifications from Parents Gateway.

Celebrations during Curriculum

The school does not encourage birthday celebrations during curriculum time. While we appreciate your effort in sharing your child's birthday with his classmates, we also note the increasing number of students with various types of food allergies. The school would be grateful if parents refrain from celebrating their children's birthday in school. We seek your understanding on this matter.

Dismissal

To ensure the safety and security of our students during dismissal, students taking the school bus will be allowed to board their school buses before we allow other motor vehicles into the school compound.

Pickup points

All P1 students will have to assemble in the school hall first and will then be taken to the various dismissal points by the teachers.

Parents Gateway



What is Parents Gateway?

Parents Gateway is a mobile app developed by MOE to support parents' involvement in their child's educational journey. The app enables you to receive information from the school and perform a range of administrative functions such as giving consent for school programmes and activities, and declaring travel plans.

Access to Parents Gateway

Access to Parents Gateway is granted to parents, legal guardians and authorized caregivers of students studying in MOE schools in Singapore. You will need your SingPass to access Parents Gateway.

We encourage you to download Parents Gateway on your mobile phone (available on iOS and Android platforms only) from 5 October 2021.

School will continue to issue hardcopy letters and consent forms to parents who are unable to access Parents Gateway.

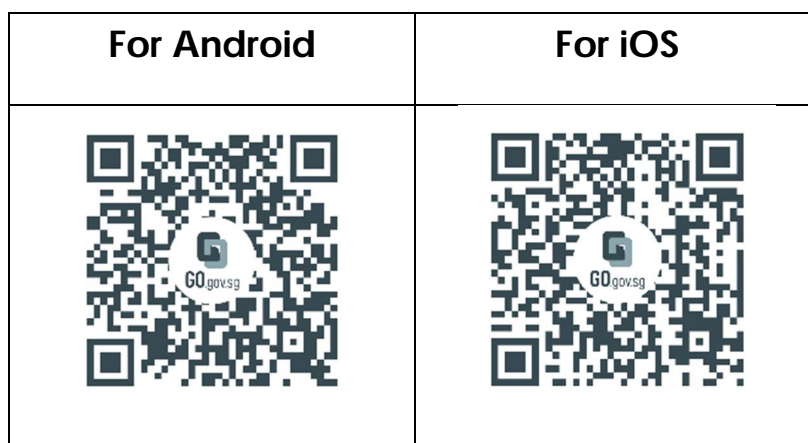
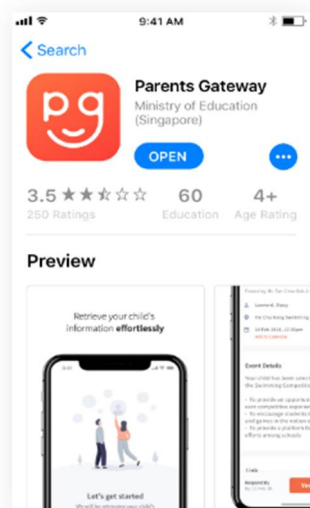
Step 1 – SingPass Registration and 2FA Setup

Step 2 – Download Parents Gateway Mobile App

- a) Open the Apple App Store, Huawei App Gallery or Google Play Store app on your mobile phone.
- b) Search for the 'Parents Gateway' mobile app, or scan the QR code below.

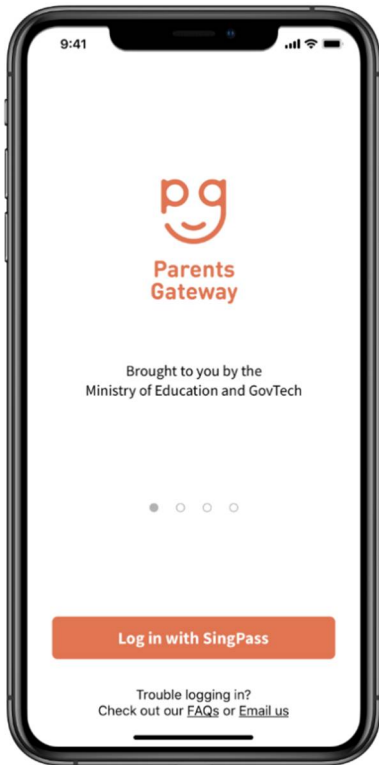


- c) Download and install the app onto your phone.
- d) Enable '**Allow Notifications**' to receive push notifications.

1. Tap on “Log in with SingPass”

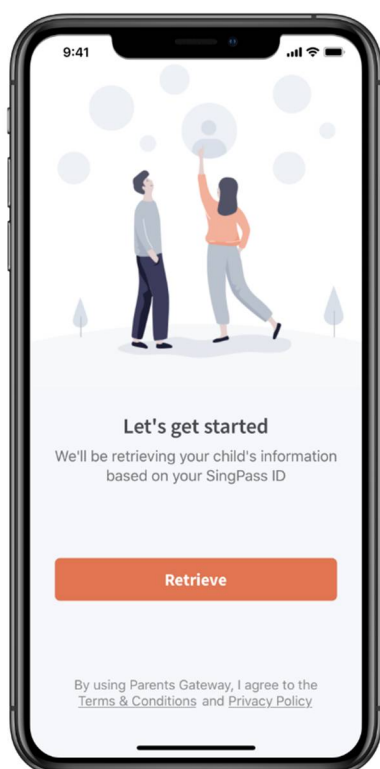


2. Log in with your SingPass (2FA)



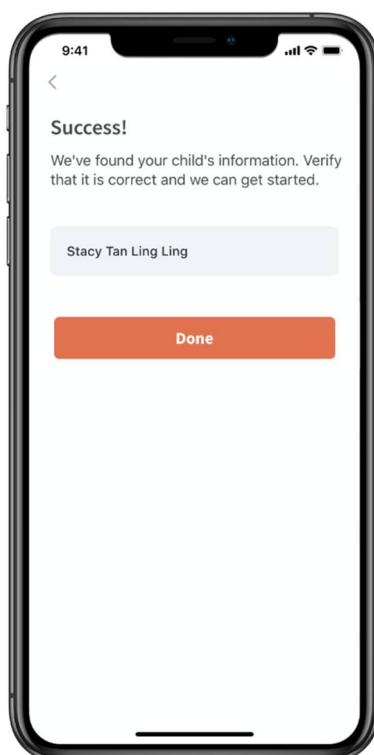

Tap on “Retrieve” to retrieve your child’s information.



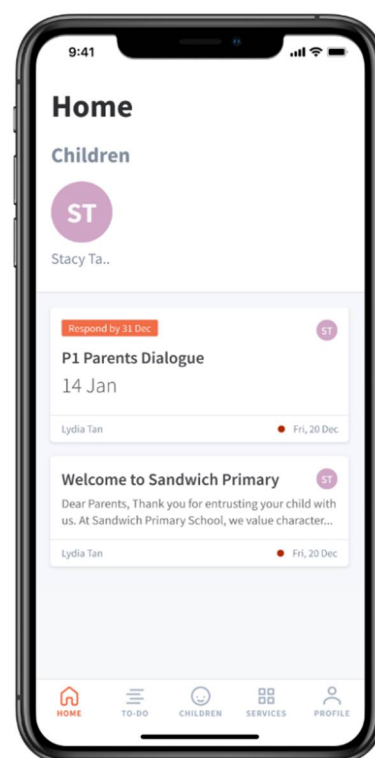

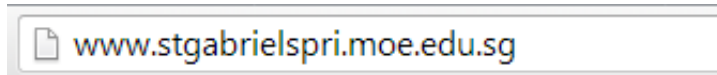

Singapore Student Learning Space



The Student Learning Space (SLS), developed by Ministry of Education and GovTech, is a student-centric learning platform that enhances existing teaching and learning in schools. Every student will be provisioned with an account on the SLS. Your child's Form Teacher will inform you and your child of his login details at the start of the school year, once his account is ready. The URL to access SLS is <https://learning.moe.edu.sg>.

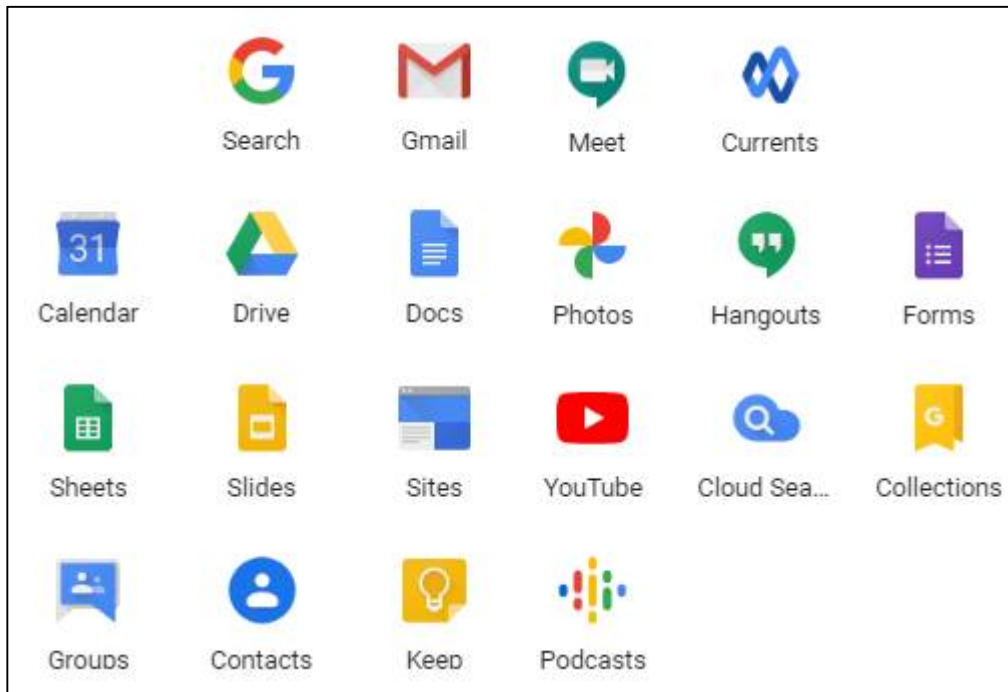
You child will have tasks and assignments to complete on the SLS which will require him to have access to the SLS beyond school hours. The SLS is accessible through Internet browsers on Windows PCs, Macs, iPads or Android tablets. For a good user experience, tablets should have a screen size of at least 7 inches.

Google Account for Students

Important Information for First Day of School (4 JAN 2022)

- Parents are to make the necessary transport arrangements to pick up their P1 child at **12.30 p.m. on 4 January 2022.**
 - For students who have registered with the school bus vendor, the school bus services will be as per usual (1.30 p.m. for Mondays to Thursdays, and 1.00 p.m. on Fridays)

We encourage parents to give your child some space to exercise his independence. Rest assured that your child is in good hands.

Safe Management Measures

In order to safeguard the wellbeing of our students and staff members, all students will need to practise the following:

- Wearing of the face mask is compulsory. Face shield is not allowed. Please pack extra face masks in their bag in case it is soiled or lost. **Each student is to bring a zip-lock bag with their full name and class written on it.** They will keep their mask in the zip-lock bag when consuming food and during PE when instructed by their teachers.
- Taking of their own temperature in the morning upon arrival at school. The school will issue each P1 student a thermometer on the first day of school.
 - Students who are at/above the trigger temperature (38.0°C) or are exhibiting flu-like symptoms e.g. sore throat, fever, cough, runny nose, loss of smell must not be involved in school activities and should seek medical attention immediately.
- No sharing of storybooks or stationery
- Be socially responsible
 - Do not report to school if he is unwell
- For students taking the school bus
 - Fixed seating on the bus
 - Required to put on mask at all times
- Practice of good personal hygiene by washing hands with soap and water regularly
- Doing the Wipe-down routine
