We are happy to share that there was very good response for the recently concluded P1 Registration Exercise. All 150 available places for 2024 were taken by new P1 students. Balloting was conducted at Phase 2C supplementary for Singapore Citizens living outside 2km. We would like to thank parents who are old boys, have children currently with us and those whose children have graduated for their strong support and confidence in the school.

There is much excitement with Teacher's Day celebrations and Term 3 holidays around the corner. I have spoken to the boys in the past two weeks about Teacher's Day being a special occasion to thank and show appreciation to their teachers. At the same time, I have also shared that they can do it without having to spend money buying gifts. They are encouraged to write cards, draw a picture or make something from recycled materials. It is the sincerity and thought that counts and teachers would appreciate their gesture.

Primary School Leaving Examinations (PSLE)

Our Primary 6 students will be taking their <u>PSLE Listening Comprehension Examination (English and Mother Tongue Language)</u> on <u>15 September, Friday</u>.

The <u>PSLE Written Examination</u> will be conducted from <u>28 September to 4 October 2023</u>. Please note that the dismissal time for candidates will vary from day to day, depending on the end time of the examination and packing process.

Examination Matters

1. Primary 3 to 5 Year-End Examinations

- The Year-End Examination Timetables will be available on Parents' Gateway and the school website from Monday, 28 August 2023.
- The exam will commence on Thursday, 19 October 2023 instead of Friday, 20 October 2023.

2. Change in English Language Paper 1 Exam Day

- Please take note that English Languages Paper 1 will be conducted on Thursday, 19 October 2023. This is reflected in the Examination Timetable.
- We will not be re-posting the Assessment Plans to highlight this change as there is no change to the other exam dates or topics to be tested.

3. Oral Examinations

- Oral Examinations for both English and Mother Tongue Languages will be conducted after school on the stipulated days.
- A briefing on the procedures of the Oral Examinations will be conducted on Friday, 13 October 2023.
- We seek your understanding on the staggered dismissal timing as the duration of the Oral examination for each child is dependent on his oracy skill. To ensure that the boys who are taking the school bus do not miss the 3.30 p.m. school bus service, they would be scheduled to take their oral examinations earlier.

4. Suspension of After School Curriculum

- There will be no remedial/ supplementary lessons and CCAs from Monday, 16 October 2023.

Focus of the Month: Teaching our children to save for a rainy day

Focus of the Month - Teaching our children to save for a rainy day

In August 2023, our Prime Minister, Mr Lee Hsien Loong gave some insights into Singapore's reserves, what makes up our nation's reserves and who manages them. However, he explained that although we currently have enough at present, it may or may not be enough if we face a catastrophe. The pandemic taught us not to take things for granted.



Just like how our country saves up for a rainy day, we will need to teach our Gabrielites on the importance of saving up for a rainy day and the best time to instill good financial habits is when they are young. Here are some strategies for parents to be part of this educational process:

Lead by Example: We cannot help but reiterate this. It not only applies to teaching Gabrielites how to save, but also in terms of character. Parents should demonstrate responsible financial behavior themselves. Children often learn best by observing their parents' actions, so make sure you're setting a good example by saving money, budgeting, and making wise financial decisions.

Set Savings Goals Together: Work with your child to set specific savings goals. Get them to use the strategies learnt in your G.R.O.W sessions and start by setting short-term goals (like saving for a new toy) and long-term goals (like saving for college). Make a visual representation of these goals, such as a chart or jar to collect money, to make the concept more tangible and exciting.

Allowance and Budgeting: Give your child an allowance and help them create a budget. Give them an amount for their daily recess or a weekly allowance. Teach them to allocate a portion of their allowance for saving, spending, and sharing (e.g., giving to charity). This helps them understand the importance of saving while still having some money to enjoy.

Use Real-Life Examples: Share real-life examples of emergencies or unexpected expenses where having savings was beneficial. Discuss how these situations could have been more challenging without savings. Never under estimate children!

Celebrate Milestones: When your child reaches a savings milestone, celebrate their achievement. This positive reinforcement can motivate them to continue saving. This applies to their academic learning as well. Celebrate small successes!

We hope that parents can continue to be instrumental in developing our Gabrielites to be responsible gentlemen.
